## 2018-2020 Sport and Recreation Victoria Grants Funding Programs and Categories

## 2018/19 Female Friendly Facilities Fund (FFFF)

This new funding program under Sport and Recreation Victoria is designed to facilitate and retain participation by women and girls through developing sports facilities such as pavilions, courts and grounds. Up to a total of \$500,000 across an unlimited number of projects.

2019/20 Community Sport Infrastructure Fund (CSIF)

- <u>Better Pools -</u> Grants of up to \$3,000,000 to upgrade existing or development of new aquatic facilities
- <u>Major Facilities -</u> Grants of up to \$800,000 where the total project cost is more than \$500,000 to develop or upgrade major district or regional facilities
- <u>Small Aquatic Projects -</u> Grants of up to \$250,000 to improve and upgrade aquatic facilities, seasonal pools and develop new water play spaces.
- <u>Minor Facilities -</u> Grants of up to \$250,000 for any one project (up to \$1 million in value) to develop or upgrade local facilities.
- Local Recreation Planning Up to \$30,000 for local planning and initiatives.
- <u>Regional planning</u> Grants of up to \$50,000 for regional initiatives, demonstrating inter-municipal outcomes and involvement across two or more local government authorities.
