Collected weekly and turned into compost

Recycling (Yellow lid)

Collected fortnightly and recycled

Landfill (Red lid)

Collected fortnightly and goes to landfill






All food scraps: fruit and vegetables, bread, cereal, rice, noodles, meat scraps and dairy (loose or wrapped in newspaper or paper towel)



Garden prunings and weeds





Paper and cardboard



Hard plastic bottles and containers



Glass bottles and jars




Cans and tins, foil (scrunched in a ball), empty aerosols

- Loose, not in a plastic bag
- No soft plastics



Broken pyrex, ceramic, crockery, glass and mirror



Nappies, textiles, polystyrene and foam



Cartons (milk, juice and long-life) and coffee cups

How to put your bins out

Place bins out before 6am on collection day, half a metre apart and away from trees, power poles



If your bin goes missing or is damaged report it online or call us. You can also downsize, upsize or order extra bins. Visit nillumbik.vic.gov.au/bins



Do not over compact or over fill your bin; the lid must be closed.





O Due to Christmas Day, New Year's Day, Good Friday and Anzac Day public holidays, bins will be collected one day later for that day and the remainder of that week.
