Summary

This report summarises submissions received in response to public consultation on the draft Eltham Major Activity Centre Structure Plan.

It is an action of the Council Plan to review the Eltham Major Activity Centre Structure Plan (2004), which is now outdated. To this end, Council developed a new draft structure plan. A copy of the draft structure plan is provided as **Attachment 1**.

On 25 February 2020, Council endorsed the draft structure plan for community consultation, which was conducted from 10 March to 29 April 2020 (7 weeks). Council received 36 submissions during the consultation. A redacted <u>summary</u> of submissions is provided as **Attachment 2** and a redacted copy of <u>all</u> submissions is provided as **Attachment 3**.

There is appreciable support in submissions for a number of the objectives and strategies within the plan, such as improving the design and walkability of the Bridge Street Business Area and support for community uses in vicinity of the Eltham Library. However, there were also concerns raised in submissions, particularly regarding the extent and style of development proposed and/or entertained, a perceived lack of support for indigenous vegetation and a lack of certainty regarding a number of the plan's terms, objectives and strategies.

It is an action of the Council Plan to review the Diamond Creek Major Activity Centre Structure Plan (2006), which is now outdated. To this end, Council developed a new draft structure plan. A copy of the draft structure plan is provided as **Attachment 1**.

On 25 February 2020, Council endorsed the draft structure plan for community consultation, which was conducted from 10 March to 29 April 2020 (7 weeks). Council received 43 submissions during the consultation. A redacted <u>summary</u> of submissions is provided as **Attachment 2** and a redacted copy of <u>all</u> submissions is provided as **Attachment 3**.

There is notable support in submissions for a number of the objectives and strategies within the plan, such as the provision of a multi-purpose community building and support to continue to advocate for the removal of the level crossing.
